Where is Mountain Goat Grip & Lighting based?

We are based in Denver, Colorado and service productions between Colorado, Utah and Wyoming.

How many Sprinter packages do you have?

Currently we offer one Sprinter package titled the “Mountain Goat”.

What size package is the “Mountain Goat”?

The “Mountain Goat” is a hybrid Sprinter package built out with a specific set of tools close to a traditional 2-ton G&E package but adds specialty rags, camera support and effects tools like a snow machine and hazers. This package was built on request of some of today’s most popular commercial cinematographers and photographers from New York to Los Angeles.

What is your pricing structure:

- Grip Package: including specialty rags \$500/day
- Interview Package including small LED package \$750/day
- All-in-One package: including grip, lighting, camera support, expendables \$1,500/day

Can the “Mountain Goat” service photo specific projects?

Yes, the “Mountain Goat” was not only built for video production but to service still photographers. We do not flash photography tools, only constant lighting.

What size productions can the “Mountain Goat” handle?

We service small to medium sized productions with a 1-4 person G&E crew.

As an all-in-one service, is all grip, lighting and camera support included in the Sprinter package?

Yes, we built out our Sprinter to be an all-in-one stop for a production, allowing them maximum creative control in rugged and remote areas. We also have expendables priced separately that we can further provide to a production if requested.

What expendables do you offer?

We offer power, radios, (hands-free and standard), directors monitors (7”, 17”), directors chairs, EZ-Up tents, coolers, umbrellas, trash cans, tables, v-lock/gold mount batteries, and a variety of gaff and paper tapes.

Can we rent individual grip and lighting items from you?

Yes, you can rent grip, lighting, camera support and expendables from us. We require a certificate of insurance and credit card authorization. We can deliver and pickup to the Denver area only.

Can we rent the Sprinter van on its own?

No, the Sprinter must be accompanied and driven by one of our team, typically a gaffer or key grip go out with the Sprinter.

Can you provide or recommend G&E crew to our project?

Yes, we are an experience team of grips and electricians that can service any small to medium sized project. Our strength is our combined knowledge of working safely and efficiently in austere environments.

Safety:

Our team is cut from experienced mountaineers, skiers and snowboarders that share an intimate relationship with the Rocky Mountains and know how to best maneuver in these remote and outdoor environments. We are also certified in Wilderness First Response and carry a fully first aid kit.

Where can the “Mountain Goat” Sprinter go?

The 4x4 Sprinter is rated for any high alpine pass or high desert environments in the Rocky Mountain region.

Does the “Mountain Goat” come equipped with a shot ski?

Correct, the “Mountain Goat” carries a 1980 K2 4x shot, shot ski for your après wrap celebration.

What requirements are there to rent the “Mountain Goat”?

We require a certificate of insurance, and credit card authorization form.

What is your payment process?

The “Mountain Goat” rental + mileage is billed via credit card authorization within 48hrs for project completion. Labor can be billed separately with net 30/day term.
